5. Public Outreach Update

Moyle updated group on outreach strategy. The plan is to hold three workshops during 2020. Pringle discussed the Stakeholder Assessment Interviews. The GSA agencies will need to make the initial contact with their Stakeholders and inform them of the upcoming interviews. Pringle will prepare the Interview Script and Assessment Questionnaire. The interviews will be scheduled for the last two weeks of March. Stantec needs the final stakeholder list including email address and phone number by February 21, 2020. Stantec would also prefer that all the interviews be held in a central location.

Wookey discussed the Newsletter which is almost ready for publication. She will hold off on sending it out until a date for the upcoming public outreach meeting is finalized.

6. GSP Update

Elliott stated that revised draft Section 1, Administration Information and Section 2, Plan Area, of the GSP are complete. The draft sections have been uploaded to the STRGBA GSA website for public review. They are also in the process of writing the Basin Setting section and Woodard Curran is working on the Hydrogeologic Conceptual Model and Groundwater Conditions sections. Elliot also mentioned that the STRGBA GSA and West/East Turlock GSA Coordination Meeting has been scheduled for March 12. The meeting location has yet to be determined.

7. Monitoring Wells – Location and Management

Alvarez stated that Todd Groundwater has reviewed potential locations for the new monitoring wells within the Modesto Subbasin. Alvarez also stated that monitoring wells constructed within each individual agency's jurisdiction will be maintained and permitted by that agency.
